Falls are a major threat to the health and independence of older adults. One out of every 27 Iowa residents aged 65 or older is hospitalized for a fall-related injury at an average cost of \$26,388 but falls are not an inevitable consequence of aging.

Join the Iowa Falls Prevention Coalition for its third annual symposium *Standing Together to Prevent Falls* and help us work toward routine screening of all older Iowans for fall risks and referral to evidence-based falls prevention programs in communities that have been proven to significantly reduce the risk of falls and fall-related injuries.

Conference Objectives:
